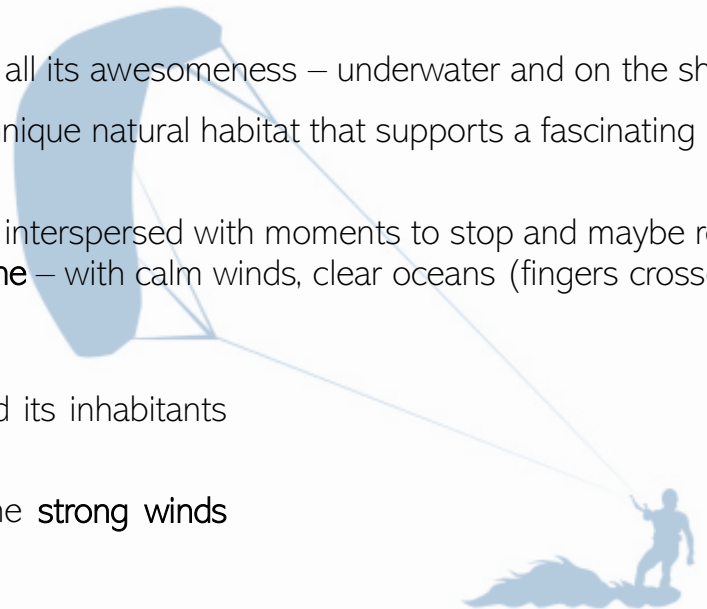
This program is ideal for anybody looking to experience the ocean in all its awesomeness – underwater and on the shore.

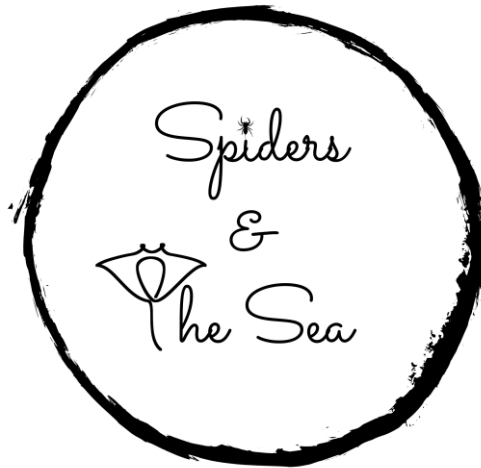
