

The Experience


This nature camp is a 3 day / 2 night program that will explore wildlife of all sizes, shapes and colours around the gorgeously wild *Liana Forest Farm*.

By Air and Rail:

- The nearest airport and train stations are in Mysore.
- Once you've reached Mysore, you will have to travel by road to the farm.

By Road:
